Huby PC Achievements in last 12 months.

Submitted proposal for double yellow lines at the junction of Robin Lane and Amin St.

Supported a S106 application from Huby Bowls Club.

Explored the process of having Tally Hill registered as a village green

Continued the process of registering Huby green spaces.

Granted funds to the Sports Pavilion towards a kitchen.

Put forward the case for a mini roundabout by the Mended Drum pub. This was rejected.

Agreed, jointly with Sutton, to fund grass cutting at the cemetery.

Found a new editor for the Huby Voice.

Agreed to refurbish the bench on Tally Hill

Provided funds to the primary school for a 'colour pack'.

Commented on 14 planning applications. Of these we objected to 5 and of these 5 one is still ongoing, one was approved and 3 have been rejected.
